ZERO NET ENERGY: The Passivhaus energy standard has been used in Europe successfully for over a decade to yield reductions in heating and cooling energy use of around 90% and overall energy use reductions of around 75%. From an energy perspective, the standard is the missing link between LEED Platinum and the Zero Net Energy Living Building Challenge.
