**Tour of the Heritage-Fillmore Jazz District and
Kabuki Hotel (formerly Miyako Hotel)**

The Fillmore district in San Francisco has historically been an area where Jazz has flourished. With the opening of various clubs such as 1300 Fillmore and Yoshi's San Francisco, and others in the area all located around The Fillmore Heritage Center, the area is set for a comeback to its origins. The Hotel Kabuki (formerly The Miyako) has gone through a renovation by Joie de Vivre Hospitality. This includes the new bar O Izakaya Lounge.
